- a safe, secure, caring and challenging environment

- your child is a regular and punctual attender
- your child is provided with all necessary materials to support their learning

- your child abides by the codes for hair, jewellery, make up and nails, as detailed overleaf
- All children who experience sickness and diarrhoea should be excluded from school and not return for a period of 48 hours
- he/she is well prepared and so able to undertake the activities of the day
- homework tasks are completed to the expected standard with reading, spellings and tables being practised daily
- the School's Admissions Policy is supported
- the professional judgements of the staff are acknowledged and respected
- the School's Healthy Eating Policy is supported
- your child abides by the Policy for Access to the Internet and use of the school's ICT network
- I/we agree to my child going on supervised local visits e.g. to the sports fields, swimming baths, church
- I/we agree to my child being photographed or filmed participating in school activities should the occasion arise
